ORDER

On October 10, 1983, William R. Reed submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.


The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 7428, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Margaretha, F.C. Nootnagel and J.W. Berry, and is for the use of not to exceed 1.94 cubic feet per second of water from Cold Springs, Trout Creek and Nootnagel Reservoir, with a date of priority of January 29, 1916, for primary irrigation of 5.0 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, 30.0 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, 40.0 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 40.0 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and supplemental irrigation of 35.0 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and 10.0 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, all in Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 7428, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
