ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7365 submitted by

ROSS ISLAND SAND & GRAVEL COMPANY 4315 SE McLOUGHLIN BOULEVARD PORTLAND, OREGON 97282-0149.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 67374, was perfected under Permit G-2485 with a date of priority of JUNE 25, 1963. The right allows the use of WELL 1, in the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 48.4 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SE¼ SE¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60, SECTION 34, T 1 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 800 FEET NORTH AND 130 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 34, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ 40.0 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60
SECTION 34

NW¼ SW¼ 8.4 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60
SECTION 35

TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

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The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes an additional point of appropriation at:

SE% SE%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60, SECTION 34, T 1 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 795 FEET NORTH AND 5 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 34.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. The water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The use of water from the new well shall be in conformance with the requirements of the Cooper Mountain-Bull Mountain Critical Ground Water Area order.
- 5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 67374 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
