ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

### **Findings of Fact**

- Bizon Nursery filed an application for an additional point of appropriation under Certificate 47637. The Department assigned the application number T-9367.
- The application map was amended by the applicant on June 10, 2004.

4. Application T-9367 proposes to add an additional point of appropriation approximately 360 feet northwest of the existing point of appropriation:

- 5. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 7. A pump, pipeline, and sprinker system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right is present.
- 8. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 9. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

The additional point of appropriation proposed in application T-9367 appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The additional point of appropriation proposed in T-9367 is approved, subject to the following conditions:

1. The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 47637 and any related decree.

- 2. Certificate 47637 is cancelled; Certificate 80647 shall be issued to describe the remaining rights NOT affected by this transfer.
- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 4. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2005.
- 5. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2006.
- 6. The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 7. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction, and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 8. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming the transferred water rights shall be issued.
