Findings of Fact

1. On June 15, 2016, the Department issued Special Order Volume 101, Page 84 cancelling Permit G-11812 pursuant to OAR 690-320-0020.
2. On August 12, 2016, the Department received a request for reconsideration from the permit holder.
3. The Department has reconsidered the order canceling the permit
4. Based on evidence presented to the Department; the Department on its own motion elects to reconsider its Final Order of June 15, 2016.


Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
