On May 2, 1983, D.R. and R.M. Goodell submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 35285, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Federal Land Bank, and is for the use of water from Johnson Creek, with a date of priority of 1905, for irrigation of 28.0 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32; 13.5 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 38.6 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 12.8 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 33, Township 8 South, Range 25 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 35285, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

The right to use water from John Day River for irrigation of said lands is not affected by this order.
