ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4360

On January 3, 1980, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Reginald F. Paddon for approval of a change in place of use of water from Calapooya Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 22389, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Esselstrom Logging Company, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.64 cubic foot per second from Calapooya Creek for irrigation of a certain 24.5 acres in SW4 NE4, 7.6 acres in SE4 NE4, 1.0 acre in NE4 SE4 and 18.1 acres in NW4 SE4 of Section 29, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M., all as projected within Burk D.L.C. No. 42, with a date of priority of December 15, 1952.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 110 feet North and 1220 feet East from the Southwest Corner of W.C. Burk D.L.C. No. 42, being within the NW4 SE4 of Section 29, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 11.6 acres in NW4 NW4 and 2.5 acres in SW4 NW4 of Section 28, as projected within T. Barnard D.L.C. No. 63; 13.4 acres in NE4 NE4 and 11.1 acres in SE4 NE4 of Section 29, as projected within T. Barnard D.L.C. No. 63; 2.4 acres in NE4 NE4, 1.5 acres in SE4 NE4, 2.2 acres in NW4 NE4, and 6.5 acres in SW4 NE4 of Section 29, as projected within W.C. Burk D.L.C. No. 42, all in Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 22389, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
