ORDER

On May 25, 1978, Edward T. Brentano submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 42233, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Edward T. Brentano, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second of water from a certain ground water aquifer, with a date of priority of July 7, 1970, for the irrigation of a certain 5.2 acres in NW4 NW4, 5.4 acres in SW4 NW4 and 4.6 acres in SE4 NW4 of Section 21, Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 42233, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
