ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6269 submitted by

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to use the waters of A WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 33.7 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 53145 was perfected under Permit G-7849 with a date of priority of JANUARY 13, 1978. The right is limited to 0.42 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at Well 2.

Well 2, the new point of appropriation, is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 27 S, R 18 E, W.M.; 490 FEET NORTH AND 110 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 31.8 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.9 ACRES
SECTION 20
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
2. The quantity of water diverted at Well 2 shall not exceed the quantity of water available at Well 1.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The well must include an access port.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
6. The following former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:


NE 1/4 SE 1/4 7.3 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 8.2 ACRES
SECTION 20

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 5.9 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 6.1 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 6.2 ACRES
SECTION 21

TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

Certificate 53145 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
