OF A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE OF WATER
FROM CALAPOOYA CREEK

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3480

On October 13, 1976, Ralph Winniford filed an application for transfer of water right in the office of the Water Resources Director proposing a change in place of use under an existing right of record as described by the certificate recorded at Page 29486, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Ralph Winniford which includes the use of not to exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second from Calapooya Creek for irrigation of 11.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 10.5 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 4, 1957.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 540 feet South and 520 feet West from the Northeast corner of Barrett D.L.C. #54, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the place of use and sever the right therefrom and to irrigate a certain 18.9 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, 0.2 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, and 2.8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster of District No. 15, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Ralph Winniford and recorded at Page 29486, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to Ralph Winniford.
