Findings of Fact

1. On March 31, 2014, Gayle M. Callis, Trustee, on behalf of Marjorie E. Jones Trust and Gayle M. Callis Revocable Trust, filed an application to temporarily transfer the place of use under Certificates 74653, 74654, 84068, and 89069 for a period of five years. The Department assigned the application number T-11774.
2. On May 14, 2014, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving T-11774. This order was recorded in the Special Order Volume 92, Page 455.
3. On May 7, 2015, Mark Dickman, of Dickman Farms, Inc., lessee of the lands involved in the transfer, submitted a request to terminate the temporary transfer prior to the expiration date in the order and revert this right back to the place of use evidenced by the respective certificate.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Temporary Transfer Application T-11774, in the name of Gayle M. Callis Revocable Trust and Marjorie E. Jones Trust, is terminated and of no further force or effect. The water rights should immediately revert back to the original place of use.
