This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Findings of Fact

- 1. Tyler Hansell filed Permit Amendment Application T-8335, on September 20, 1999, requesting changes in point of appropriation and place of use for Permits G-10651 and G-10836.
- 2. No action was taken on the application.
- 3. Don Key filed Transfer Application 9159, on June 24, 2002, requesting a change in place of use of a portion of a water right, to the same land described by Permit Amendment Application 8335. Transfer Application 9159 was approved July 30, 2003.
- 4. The Department sent a letter to Mr. Hansell, on March 30, 2006, suggesting he withdraw Permit Amendment Application T-8335. Mr. Hansell did not respond.
- 5. The Department mailed proposed certificates on May 23, 2006, to Tyler Hansell, holder of Permit G-10651, and County Line Water Improvement District, holder of Permit G-10836
- 6. Neither Mr. Hansell nor the County Line Water Improvement District requested reconsideration of the proposed certificates within the time limit allowed.
- 7. Final certificates are being issued for Permits G-10651 and G-10836.

8. It appears Permit Amendment T-8335 is no longer needed and should be rejected.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Permit Amendment Application T-8335 is **REJECTED** and of no further force or effect.
