Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Applicant

CAMERON, KEATON AND LOUIS MOLT 72299 TURNOUT ROAD BURNS OR 97720

Findings of Fact

- 1. On September 14, 2015, CAMERON, KEATON AND LOUIS MOLT filed an application for additional points of appropriation under Certificates 35133, 82398, and 90199. The Department assigned the application number T-12164.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on September 22, 2015, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. In the initial review the department found that a temporary Transfer T-11386 exists and affects a portion of the lands modified by T-12164 and T-12172. T-11386 will terminate upon approval of T-12164 and T-12172.
- 4. On April 20, 2016, the Department sent a copy of the Draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12164 to the applicants. The Draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of May 20, 2016, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the completion date be extended to October 1, 2022 and for the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 5. On September 15, 2016, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12164 and sent a copy to the applicant(s). Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on September 20, 2016, and in the Burns Times-Herald newspaper on March 15 and 22, 2017, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 13. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 14. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-12164.
- 15. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 16. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 17. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-12164 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-12164 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 35133, 82398, and 90199 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 35133, 82398, and 90199 are cancelled.
- 4. Temporary transfer T-11386 will be terminated upon approval of T-12164 and T-12172 and/or the initial termination date in the original order, whichever comes first.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
- 6. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 7. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 8. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2022. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
