
Findings of Fact

1. On July 31, 2018, the Department issued an order approving Temporary Transfer Application T-12925. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 108, Pages 995-998.
2. Under the order, the water right would revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2020 irrigation season.
3. The most recent use of water at the place of use authorized under the temporary transfer was during the 2018 irrigation season.
4. On December 5, 2019, Dave Kauer submitted a written request via email, asking that temporary transfer application T-12925 be voluntarily terminated.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Temporary Transfer T-12925, in the name of KAUER FAMILY FARMS, C/O DAVE KAUER, is withdrawn and of no further force or effect.
