ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION (WELL 10)

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6005 submitted by

OREGON DEPARTMENT OF VETERAN'S AFFAIRS (RICHARD E. & MARTHA J. BISHOP)
700 SUMMER STREET, N.E.
SALEM, OREGON 97310

to use the waters of 2 WELLS in the DEEP CANYON CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 109.7 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 53613, NOT cancelled by an order of the Water Resources Director entered in Special Order Record Volume 40, at page 501, was perfected under Permit G-7360 with a date of priority of DECEMBER 15, 1976. This right is limited to 0.799 cubic foot per second, if available at WELL 8, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 64142, was perfected under Permit G-10677 with a date of priority of JULY 11, 1986. This right is limited to 0.57 cubic foot per second, if available at WELL 8, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

WELL 8 is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 14 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 2350 FEET SOUTH AND 1060 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 20.

The additional point of appropriation (WELL 10) is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 14 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 50 FEET SOUTH AND 860 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation under these rights is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well 10) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation (well 8).
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
5. The well at the new point of appropriation (well 10) shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 64142 is hereby canceled. Certificate 53613 was cancelled by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 15, 1986. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of Certificate 53613 NOT cancelled and NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
