FINAL ORDER APPROVING AN
EXTENSION OF TIME

Findings of Fact

1. On September 24, 2004, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right from Marc Thalacker, Manager of Three Sisters Irrigation District.
2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-8994 on October 30, 2002. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 56, at Page 2021. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2004, and the date for submission of a claim of beneficial use as October 1, 2005.
3. The applicant has planted and irrigated 19 acres.
4. The applicant requested an extension because they are unable to complete development of the requested place of use by the completion date. The applicant needs to plant and irrigate the remaining 11 acres.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-8994.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW



Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the change in place of use, authorized by T-8994 shall be extended to October 1, 2005.
