**Authority**

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

**Findings of Fact**

1. On June 12, 2020, SHOTGUN RANCH, LLC, ATTN: JOE PAPINEAU filed an application for additional points of appropriation under Permits G-17700 and G-18245. The Department assigned the application number T-13465.
2. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on July 7, 2020, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. For Permits G-17700 and G-18245, Permit Amendment Application T-13465 proposes additional points of appropriation located approximately as follows:

17 S	20 E	WM	3	SW SW	WELL 6 - 1040 FEET NORTH AND 840 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 3	854.2 ft.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-01-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

***Permit Amendment Review Criteria***

4. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
5. The changes do not enlarge the permit.
6. The changes do not alter any other terms of the permit.

**Conclusions of Law**


The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13465 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The additional points of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13465 are approved.
2. Permit G-18479, in the name of Shotgun Ranch, Attn: Joe Papineau, is issued to replace Permit G-17700, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order. Permit G-17700, in the name of SHOTGUN RANCH LLC, is no longer of any force or effect.
3. Permit G-18480, in the name of Shotgun Ranch, Attn: Joe Papineau, is issued to replace Permit G-17700, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order. Permit G-17700, in the name of SHOTGUN RANCH LLC, is no longer of any force or effect.
4. Under Permit G-18479, the combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional points of appropriation, (Well 5 and Well 6), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, (Well 4), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation, (Well 4).
5. Under Permit G-18480, the combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional points of appropriation, (Well 5 and Well 6), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, (Well 4), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation, (Well 4).
6. Water use measurement conditions:
  - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation, (new and existing).
  - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
  - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

7. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
8. All other terms and conditions of Permits G-18479 and G-18480 remain the same.
