

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

**Findings of Fact**

1. Daniel L. LeFore submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of water right and the land to which it is appurtenant. He has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be cancelled.
2. The water right in question is a portion of the right described by Certificate 852, State Record of Water Right Certificates in the name of F. H. Olson, with a priority date of February 23, 1912.
3. The water right is for the use of water from the Little Walla Walla River for Irrigation of 5.0 acres in the NW¼, Section 26, T 6 N, R 35 E, W.M.
4. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
5. The Water Resources Director entered an order May 8, 1986, at Special Order Volume 40, Page 152, cancelling the remainder of the water right described by Certificate 852.


**Conclusions of Law**

1. ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:** that the water right, being a portion of the right described by Certificate 852, State Record of Water Right Certificates, for use of water from the Little Walla Walla River for Irrigation of 2.79 acres, is cancelled.
