## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On April 7, 2003, a Short-Term Lease Application, which proposed to lease a portion of certificates 76358 (primary) and 76714 (supplemental) for instream purposes was submitted to the Department by:

Lessor #1 Daryl C. Cronen 6150 NW Kingwood Ave. Redmond, OR 97756 Lessor #2 Central Oregon Irrigation District 2598 N. Hwy 97 Redmond, OR 97756

Lessee Deschutes River Conservancy P.O. Box 1560 Bend, OR 9770

- 2. The Department assigned this lease agreement number L-402.
- 3. The lease application requested to protect water instream for five years, terminating on October 31, 2007. A Final Order approving this lease was issued by the Department on May 21, 2003, as evidenced by Special Order Volume 57, Page 695. The final order contains a condition allowing the Lessor (Lessor #1 or Lessor #2) to terminate the lease prior to water being protected instream in any year that the lease is in effect.
- 4. On February 16, 2006, the Department received a request from Lessor #1, Lessor #2, and the new landowner, William Armstrong, to terminate the lease prior to the 2006 irrigation season.
- 5. The lease was exercised through the 2005 water use period, ending on October 31, 2005.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department concludes that terminating the lease in advance of the 2006 irrigation season is consistent with OAR 690-077.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
