ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE  
AND A CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8079 submitted by

JOHN F. WOOD  
570 NORTH 10<sup>TH</sup> #100  
CORNELIUS, OREGON, 97113.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 40734, was perfected under Permit 33778 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 25, 1968. The right allows the use of A SPRING, a tributary of WEST DAIRY CREEK, for STOCK USE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 9, T 1 N, R 4 W, W.M.; 1120 FEET SOUTH AND 1830 FEET EAST FROM THE W $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER OF SECTION 9, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
SECTION 9

TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

NE¼ SW¼  
SECTION 9

TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the character of use from STOCK USE to COMMERCIAL USE.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.
2. The use of water for commercial use shall be limited to 0.005 cubic foot per second or 2.24 gallons per minute and shall not exceed 3231 gallons per day at anytime of year that beneficial use is made.
3. The former place of use shall no longer receive water as a part of this water right.

Certificate 40734 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
