ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8361 submitted by

SP NEWSPRINT CO.
P.O. BOX 70
NEWBERG, OREGON 97132-0070.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 37773, was perfected under Permit 8106 with a date of priority of JULY 30, 1927. The right allows the use of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for manufacturing and fire protection. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 8.0 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: E½ NW¼, SECTION 29, T 3 S, R 2 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.


5. The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The water user may participate in the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's cost sharing program for installation of screening and by-pass devices in accordance with ORS 540.525.

Certificate 37773 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed additional point of diversion is received, a new certificate confirming that change will be issued.
