Authority

Oregon Revised Statue (ORS) 540.570 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to temporarily transfer a water right within district boundaries. Findings of Fact

- 1. On March 22, 2018, Echo Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to temporarily change the places of use within the boundaries of the irrigation district under Certificates 85124, 92001, 87042, 80849, 80850, 87667, 87666, 87111, and Water Use Permit S-54773. The Department assigned the application number T-12874.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on March 27, 2018, pursuant to ORS 540.570 and OAR 690-385-3400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On April 10, 2018, the Department contacted the Agent for the applicant by e-mail with regard to deficiencies in application T-12874.

- 28. The district temporary transfer application satisfies the criteria of ORS 540.570 and OAR 690-385-3000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-3200, and includes a map meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-3300.
- 29. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 30. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 31. Diversion structures, district canals, pumps, pump stations, ditches, pipeline, and sprinkler systems sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
- 32. The proposed change in place of use, as conditioned, will not result in enlargement of the rights as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(6).
- 33. The proposed change in place of use would not result in injury to other water rights as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(4).
- 34. All other applicable requirements for district temporary water right transfers are met.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary change in place of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-12874 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.570 and OAR 690-385-3500.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The temporary changes in place of use and point of appropriation and/or diversion to serve the proposed place of use in Transfer Application T-12874 are approved.
- 2. The former places of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2018 irrigation season.
- 3. The areas outside of pivots being transferred in Sections 6 and 7 in Township 3 North, Range 30 East, and in Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, and 14 in Township 3 North, Range 29 East described as supplemental water in Water Use Permit S-54773 will not be transferred and will remain unexercised at the authorized place of use during the 2018 irrigation season.
- 4. Certificate 87111(3 Acre feet/AC). Any portions of Cert. 87111(3 Acre feet/AC) associated with lands being transferred from S-54773 will be transferred to other places of use. (2) Cert. 87667. Any portions of Cert. 87667 associated.

- 5. For primary irrigation of 25.5 acres, from permit S-54773, will be transferred to another place of use for the 2018 irrigation season. All other portions of S-54773 associated with the portion of Certificate 87667 being temporarily transferred will remain in place and not be exercised during the 2018 irrigation season.
- 6. The primary acres of permit S-54773 associated with the portions of Cert. 87111 (3Acre feet/AC) will be transferred to other places of use for the 2018 irrigation season. (2) Permit S-54773 supplemental acres. The supplemental portion of Permit S-54773 associated with portions of Cert. 87111 (1Acre feet/AC) will remain in place for the 2018 irrigation season. (3) Cert. 87042. The portion of Cert. 87042 associated with the portion of 87111 (1 acre foot/AC) being transferred will remain in place and not be part of this transfer
- 7. The portions of supplemental water from Permit S-54773 associated with portions of Certificates 80849, 80850, 87042, 87666, 92001, and 85124, affected by this transfer will not be transferred or exercised during the regular 2018 irrigation season.
- 8. Any application for permanent transfer of Certificates 85124, 92001, 87042, 80849, 80850, 87667, 87666, 87111, and Water Use Permit S-54773 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Divisions 380 or 385. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- 9. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture of Certificates 85124, 92001, 87042, 80849, 80850, 87667, 87666, 87111, and Water Use Permit S-54773, under ORS 540.610.
- 10. The use of water on the lands, from which the water right is transferred and at the new temporary place of use, during the same irrigation season or calendar year is prohibited and may subject the district and/or landowners to civil penalties.
- 11. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement devices and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.

12. Water use measurement conditions:

- a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion (new and existing).
- b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 13. The use of water under this temporary transfer may be conditioned or revoked at any time to the extent necessary to avoid injury if the Department finds the transfer causes injury to any existing water right.
- 14. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 85124, 92001, 87042, 80849, 80850, 87667, 87666, 87111, and Water Use Permit S-54773 and any related order or decree.

- 15. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 85124, 92001, 87042, 80849, 80850, 87667, 87666, 87111, and Water Use Permit S-54773, not involved in this transfer shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 85124, 92001, 87042, 80849, 80850, 87667, 87666, 87111, Water Use Permit S-54773 and any related order or decree.
- 16. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use, and authorized points of appropriation and/or diversions after the 2018 irrigation season.
