## BEFORE THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR OF OREGON

ORDER

On February 23, 1978, Agnes Cooke submitted an affidavit that she is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that she has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 35495, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Ralph A. Case, and is for the use of water from Case Well, with a date of priority of March 5, 1964, for the irrigation of:

6.0 acres within NE4 SE4

and supplemental irrigation of:

1.2 acres within NE¼ SE¼ 19.4 acres within NW¼ SE¼

6.4 acres within SW4 SE4

1.6 acres within SE¼ SE¼

Section 21

Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 35495, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof, a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
