ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE
AND A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8579 submitted by

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 74193, was perfected under Permit 36940 with a date of priority of JUNE 29, 1973. The right allows the use of the COLUMBIA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 75.5 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.87 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LOT 7 (NE¼ NW¼), SECTION 2, T 4 N, R 25 E, W.M.; SOUTH 86 DEGREES 22 MINUTES 46 SECONDS WEST, 2811 FEET FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under an other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.


THESE TEMPORARY CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. These changes are temporary. These changes shall be effective upon issuance of this order.

2. The former place of use shall not be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003 irrigation seasons.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2003 irrigation season.
4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
5. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
6. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 74193 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 74193.
