ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6049 submitted by

WEBSTER BRIGGS 4422 GAZLEY ROAD MYRTLE CREEK, OREGON 97457

to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 16.0 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 47504, was perfected under Permit 21874 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 31, 1952. This right is limited to 0.20 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion: SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1800 FEET SOUTH AND 250 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The new point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 23, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 800 FEET NORTH AND 3090 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.7 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 6.2 ACRES NW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.4 ACRES SW 1/4 SE 1/4 3.7 ACRES SECTION 23

TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The following described lands shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 8.8 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 7.2 ACRES BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 42 SECTION 7 TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Certificate 47504 is hereby canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
