On November 24, 1997, Donald C. Kilgras, President of Quail Valley Golf Corporation, submitted an affidavit that the corporation is the owner of certain lands and the water right appurtenant. The affidavit further states the corporation has obtained a better source of water for primary irrigation of these lands and requests the water right be diminished from a right for primary irrigation to a right for supplemental irrigation of the same lands.

The water right to be diminished is the right described by Certificate 40330 State Record of Water Right Certificates. The water right is for the use of not to exceed 0.087 cubic foot per second of water, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from each of two springs, and 0.067 cubic foot per second from field drain tile and reservoir constructed under Permit R-5037, tributaries of East Fork Dairy Creek, for the purpose of irrigation of 30.8 acres. The date of priority is July 17, 1967.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ 21.6 ACRES SE¼ NE¼ 9.2 ACRES SECTION 31 TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that Certificate 40330 is diminished to supplemental use and a confirming certificate be issued to reflect the diminution.
