ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications. OAR Chapter 690, Division 077 provides additional criteria for evaluating transfers to instream water rights.


Findings of Fact

1. The Department issued an order approving T-9824 (MP-27) on August 3, 2005. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 655, Pages 502 to 515.
2. The order approving T-9824 contained a scrivener's error on page 13. Certificate 77591 was wrongly listed in statements #4 and #7 as Certificate 75591. Certificate 77591 is the certificate number intended in statement #4 and statement #7 on page 13.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application T-9824 (MP-27), entered August 3, 2005, and recorded in Special Order Volume 65 at Pages 502 to 515, is CORRECTED as described herein.
2. Except as modified herein, all other terms and conditions of the referenced order remain the same.
