Authority

ORS 540.570 and 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

ORS 540.621 establishes the process for the owner of land to which a water right is appurtenant to certify under oath that the water right, or a portion thereof, has been abandoned and to voluntarily request that it be cancelled.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On December 27, 2010, Stanfield Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 86202, 86203, 86204 and 86205. The Department assigned the application number T-11177.
- 2. Certificate 86202 was superseded on May 2, 2011, by correcting Certificate 87035. Certificate 86204 was superseded by correcting Certificate 86377 on June 17, 2010.
- 3. Notice of the application for transfer was published on January 4, 2011, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 4. On February 2 and March 23, 2011, the Department notified the District that conflicts with existing water rights on both the "FROM" and "TO" lands exist. In response, the District submitted affidavits to voluntarily cancel or diminish the layered water rights. The affidavits were received on April 15, April 22, July 27, August 4, October 20, and October 24, 2011.
- 5. The portion of the FIRST primary water right and its layered supplemental water rights to be transferred are as follows: (Ditchen Notice)

- 14. On February 2 and March 23, 2011, the Department notified the District of several layered water rights existing on the both the authorized and proposed places of use. The Department requested resolution of these layered conflicts by either (1) obtaining cancellation affidavits of the layered water right, (2) obtaining written authorizations to move the layered rights concurrently with the district right or (3) withdrawing the conflicting, layered portions from the transfer. The Department's March 23, 2011 letter set forth a deadline of April 22, 2011, for the applicant to respond.
- 15. On March 31, 2011, the District manager came into the Department's North Central Regional Office and submitted three voluntary cancellation affidavits and a diminishment affidavit for the Ditchen Notice.
- 16. On April 4, 2011, the District manager came into the Department's North Central Regional Office and met with staff to go over the necessary affidavits needed for the remaining Cooper Notice and reviewed portions of maps needed to accompany the cancellation affidavit(s) requests.
- 17. On August 3, 2011, the District submitted voluntary cancellation affidavits for the Anna Francis and Hermiston Veterinarian portions of the Cooper Notice.
- 18. On August 4, 2011, the District submitted a voluntary cancellation affidavit for the Brown portion of the Cooper Notice.
- 19. On October 20, 2011, the District submitted a voluntary cancellation affidavit for the Dice Properties portion of the Cooper Notice.
- 20. On October 24, 2011, the District submitted a voluntary cancellation affidavit for the Nancy Able portion of the Cooper Notice. This submission satisfied the enlargement issues associated with the layered water rights.

- 21. On April 15, 2011, Darrin Ditchen, authorized representative for Ditchen Farms, LLC, owner of lands to which a portion of Certificate 76118 is appurtenant, submitted an affidavit for the partial diminution of the water right. - 41. The District permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 42. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights and there is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 43. Diversion structures, pumps, canals, pipeline, and sprinkler systems sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
- 44. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 45. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.

46. The proposed change in place of use will not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-11177 satisfies the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed change to the District's water right evidenced by Certificates 87035, 86203, 86205 and 86377 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in water right Certificates 87035, 86203, 86205, 86377 and any related decree and the Final Order approving T-11177.
- 3. A portion of the water right evidenced by water right Certificate 76118 is diminished from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation.
- 4. Water right Certificates 76118, 76130, 54741, 43608 and 49215 are cancelled. New certificates shall be issued to confirm those portions of the rights NOT modified by this transfer.
- 5. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.
- 6. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement devices and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 7. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 2013.
- 8. A Claim of Beneficial Use (COBU) shall be submitted by Stanfield Irrigation District to the Department by October 1, 2014.
- 9. Water right certificates 87035, 86203, 86205 and 86377 are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the district's rights when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.
