## ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.211, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-8037 submitted by

WORKMAN'S AIRPARK WATER ASSOCIATION, INC. 94505 GRIBBLE ROAD CANBY, OREGON 97013.

The permit to be modified is Permit G-14093 with a date of priority of JUNE 13, 1995. The permit allows the use of THREE WELLS, in the MOLALLA RIVER BASIN, for DOMESTIC USE FOR 24 HOUSEHOLDS AND IRRIGATION OF 24.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second (CFS) BEING 0.12 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.30 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, if available at the original wells; NE% SW%, NW% SE%, SECTION 22, T 4 S, R 1 E, W.M.; WELL NO. 1 - 260 FEET SOUTH AND 280 FEET EAST, WELL NO. 2 - 460 FEET SOUTH AND 1180 FEET EAST, WELL NO. 3 - 250 FEET SOUTH AND 2030 FEET EAST, ALL FROM THE NE CORNER OF A. GRIBBLE DLC 41, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation for Well No. 3 to:

NW¼ SE¼, SECTION 22, T 4 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 260 FEET SOUTH AND 960 FEET EAST FROM THE NE CORNER OF A. GRIBBLE DLC 41.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER PERMIT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
- 2. The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the permit remain the same.
