



4. On September 3, 2021, the Department contacted the applicant by certified mail, notifying them of an incomplete transfer, and that the right involved with the transfer could be lost if a Claim of Beneficial Use or an Application for Extension of Time on Transfer T-8428 is not received. The Department requested a response by October 4, 2021.
5. On September 14, 2021, the Department received the signed certified mailing card, but the Department did not receive any further response to the incomplete transfer.
6. As of October 8, 2021, no Claim of Beneficial Use showing beneficial use of the inchoate water, or an Application for Extension of Time on Transfer T-8428 has been filed with the Department.
7. On January 4, 2022, the Department issued a Final Order (Special Order Volume 122, Page 297), approving a loss of right due to failure to apply water to beneficial use under the terms of an order approving T-8428.
8. On January 6, 2022, Daniel Horner, Bridge Water District Board Member, submitted a Request for Reconsideration in accordance with OAR 137-004-0080, on behalf of the applicant.
9. On January 26, 2022, the Department issued a Notice of Reconsideration of Final Order on Transfer Application T-8428.

#### Conclusions of Law


There is no loss of right under Transfer T-8428 for failure to submit a Claim of Beneficial Use or an Extension of Time.

#### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. This Final Order supersedes the January 4, 2022 Final Order, recorded in Special Order Volume 122, Pages 297-298.
2. The final order on loss of right recorded at Special Order Volume 122, Pages 297-298 is hereby withdrawn, and is of no further force or effect.
