ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6160 submitted by the

to use the waters of A WELL in the SNAKE RIVER BASIN for the purpose of MUNICIPAL USE.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 32124, was perfected under Permit G-999 with a date of priority of AUGUST 11, 1958. The right is limited to 2.25 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; Well #3 - LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 11, T 18 S, R 47 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new point of appropriation is located as follows:

LOT 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 2, T 18 S, R 47 E, W.M.;
Well #6 - 264 FEET NORTH AND 914 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF LOT 4.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change is complete. The claim of beneficial use shall be submitted in accordance with the transmittal letter.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
5. The well at the new point of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 32124 is canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
