
On August 4, 2005, David Ditchen of Kraemer Farms, LLC, filed an application to temporarily transfer the place of use under Certificates 26068 for a period of two years. The Department assigned the application number T-9989.

On August 11, 2005, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving T-9989. This order was recorded in the Special Order Volume 66, Page 78.

On May 10, 2006, Duane Ditchen of Golden Valley Farms, LLC and Kraemer Farms, LLC, submitted a request to terminate the temporary transfer prior to the expiration date in the order and revert this right back to the place of use evidenced by the respective certificate.

Temporary Transfer Application T-9989, in the name of Kraemer Farms, LLC, is Terminated and of no further force or effect. The water rights should immediately revert back to the original place of use.
