O R D E R

APPROVING APPLICATION

On July 10, 1930, Union High School District No. 2, Baker County, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Eagle Creek, a tributary of Powder River.

By decree of the circuit court for Baker County, dated March 18, 1918, in the matter of the determination of the relative rights of the various claimants to the waters of Powder River, a water right was recognized in the name of Mary Long for the irrigation of 24 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1878, from Eagle Creek through the Moody Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located near the center of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of 5 acres of the above-described land, proposes to change the point of diversion for the irrigation of said 5 acres to the head of the Kay Young Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located 150 feet south and 100 feet west from the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., was given in the Baker County Record, a newspaper of general circulation in Baker County, for a period of at least three weeks and not less than one publication each week, being the issues of July 29, August 5, 12, and 19, 1930.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Eagle Creek for the irrigation of 5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1878, to-wit: From a point near the center of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$, Section 3, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W. M., to a point located 150 feet south and 100 feet west from the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W. M., being the head of the Kay Young Ditch, be and the same hereby is approved.
