



**Permit Amendment Review Criteria**

6. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
7. The change does not enlarge the permit.
8. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.


**Conclusions of Law**

The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-11551 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-11551 is approved.
2. Permit G-17116, in the name of A.J. DAIRY LLC, is issued to replace Permit G-12367, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order, the extension of time, and assignments. Permit G-12367, in the name of A J DAIRY LLC, is no longer of any force or effect.
3. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
4. Water use measurement conditions:
  - a. Before water use from the proposed additional point of appropriation may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at the new point of appropriation.
  - b. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
  - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.
6. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-17116 remain the same.
