ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8592 submitted by

KENNETH COPPINGER
75235 COPPINGER LAND
ECHO, OREGON 97826.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 49733, was perfected under Permit G-6626 with a date of priority of DECEMBER 29, 1975. The right allows the use of COPPINGER WELLS NO. 1 AND 2, in the STAGE GULCH BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 115.3 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.22 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ NE¼, SE¼ NE¼, SECTION 24, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M.; WELL NO. 1 - 20 FEET NORTH AND 1570 FEET WEST; WELL NO. 2 - 960 FEET NORTH AND 30 FEET WEST; BOTH FROM THE E¼ CORNER, SECTION 24, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	30.0 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	30.0 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	25.3 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	30.0 ACRES

SECTION 24

TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to TEMPORARILY change the place of use to:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	22.6 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	30.3 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	40.0 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	22.4 ACRES

SECTION 18


TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 30 EAST, W.M.

THIS TEMPORARY CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. These changes are temporary. These changes shall be effective upon issuance of this order.

2. The former place of use shall not be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2000 irrigation season.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2000 irrigation season.
4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
5. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
6. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 49733 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 49733.
