Authority

ORS 540.570 and 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On September 15, 2010, Medford Irrigation District (MID) filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728 and water use Permit S-4951. The Department assigned the application number T-11133.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on September, 28, 2010, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. Final revisions and clarifications to the application were received by the Department on December 2, 2010.
- 4. On December 8, 2010, the Department signed a final order, which was mailed on December 10, 2010, and recorded in Special Order Volume 83, Pages 179-187, approving Transfer Application T-11133 involving Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728, and Permit S-4951. The final order established October 1, 2012, as the date for completion of the authorized changes in place of use.
- 5. On December 23, 2019, it came to the attention of the Department that there are scrivener's errors in the order recorded in Special Order Volume 83, Pages 179-187 as follows: one quarter-quarter location was incorrectly described for multiple certificates involved in the transfer; 0.97 acres were listed as lands being transferred under Certificates 80578 for supplemental irrigation from locations not authorized on the certificate; 1.47

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

acres were listed as lands being transferred under Certificates 83728 for supplemental irrigation from locations not authorized on the certificate, and 4.5 acres authorized on Certificate 83728 were erroneously omitted from the transfer.

- 6. This order is issued to correct the scrivener's errors described in Finding of Fact 5, above, and supersedes the final order approving Transfer Application T-11133, recorded in Special Order Volume 83, Pages 179-187. All corrections and deletions are consistent with the maps submitted with the application and the water rights of record. The corrections to the authorized and proposed places of use are show in **bold**, deletions are shown in strikeout.
- 7. The portion of the primary right to be transferred is as follows:

Priority Date: July 23, 1909

Limit/Duty: The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 88.87 cubic feet per second (cfs) into Medford Canal at Bradshaw Drop. The total diversions though the Main Canal from North Fork and South Fork of the Little Butte Creek shall not exceed 140 cfs at any one time, being 50 cfs for Rogue River Valley Irrigation District and 90 cfs for Medford Irrigation District. Total diversions from South Fork Little Butte Creek shall not exceed 100 cfs at any one time. The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to 1/100th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the season.

- 22. The District permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 23. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 24. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 25. The proposed change in place of use will not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-11133 satisfies the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The order entered at Special Order Volume 83, Pages 179-187 is withdrawn and of no further force and effect and is superseded by this order.
- 2. The proposed changes to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728 and water use Permit S-4951 are approved.
- 3. The right to the use of water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in by Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728 and water use Permit S-4951 any related decree or order.
- 4. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.
- 5. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 6. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 2012.
- 7. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted by Medford Irrigation District to the Department by October 1, 2013.
- 8. Water right by Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728 and water use Permit S-4951 are modified. The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the rights when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.
