ORDER

On April 25, 1980, Francis and Mary Marciel submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 1399, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of G.W. Reynolds and Frank Foster, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.71 cubic foot per second of water from Riley Creek, with a date of priority of May 13, 1910, for irrigation of 23.0 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 10.0 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 24.0 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 30, Township 13 South, Range 30 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 1399, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
