ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.211, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-8036 submitted by

ROBERT V. APPLEGATE AND DEBBIE L. GORHAM 19700 NW ADCOCK ROAD YAMHILL, OREGON 97148.

The permit to be modified is Permit G-13346 with a date of priority of JUNE 30, 1997. The permit allows the use of A WELL, in the YAMHILL CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 6.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.075 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 33, T 2 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 630 FEET SOUTH AND 2340 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 33, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ 3.0 ACRES
NW¼ NE¼ 3.0 ACRES
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 33, T 2 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 855 FEET SOUTH AND 2040 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 33.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER PERMIT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 2. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the permit remain the same.

Permit G-13346, in the name of ROBERT V. APPLEGATE AND DEBBIE L. GORHAM is amended as described herein.
