

6. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.


Conclusions of Law

The change in point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-12026 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-12026 is approved.
2. Permit G-17481, in the name of Dow Agrosiences, is issued to replace Permit G-17284, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order. Permit G-17284, in the name of DOW AGROSCIENCES, is no longer of any force or effect.
3. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
5. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-17284 remain the same.
