Authority

OAR 690-380-8002(3) and 690-380-8004(7) provide that the uses authorized under a temporary transfer revert to the terms and conditions of the originating water right on the written request of the applicant.

Findings of Fact


1. On April 25, 2018, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the temporary changes proposed in Application T-12834. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 107, Page 1180.
2. Under the order, the water right would revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2022 irrigation season.
3. The most recent use of water at the place of use authorized under the temporary transfer was during the 2019 irrigation season.
4. On July 17, 2019, Eric Hungate for Coyote Rock Ranch, applicant, submitted a written request that the temporary transfer be voluntarily terminated upon issuance of a Final Order approving permanent transfer T-12795. A Final Order for Transfer T-12795 is being issued concurrently with the termination of this temporary transfer.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Temporary Transfer T-12834 is terminated.
