FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On June 14, 2004, a Short-Term Lease Application, which proposed to lease a portion of certificate 74145 for instream purposes was submitted to the Department by:

- 2. The Department assigned this lease agreement number L-578.
- 3. The lease application includes the required information under OAR 690-077-0077(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(6). No comments were received.
- 4. The right to be leased, as requested by the applicant, is as follows:

Use: Irrigation

Acres: 9.8

Season of Use: April 1 through October 31, further limited as follows:

April 1 to May 1 and October 1 to November 1 described herein as

- 5. The Department finds that the lease application requires modification in order to clarify the portion of certificate 74145 that may be leased. During Season 3, the water right allows the diversion of 1/33.45th CFS for each acre to which water is applied. This certificate allows for water to be used on 4561.105 acres, including equivalent acres for uses other than irrigation. If water were being applied to all acres allowed by the certificate, the amount that could be diverted in Season 3, 136.36 CFS, would exceed the rate limitation on the certificate, 125.0 CFS. To identify the portion of this certificate that may be leased in Season 3, the Department has proportioned the 125.0 CFS allowed by the certificate to each acre on which water may be applied, which amounts to 1/36.49th CFS per acre.
- 6. Based upon Finding 5 and 6, the portion of the certificate to be leased is clarified as follows (changes are shown in bold text):

7. The application proposes to lease water for instream as follows:

Reach: From the Swalley Main Canal POD (SE NE, Section 29, T17S, R12E, W.M.; 985) feet North and 617 feet West from East 1/4 Corner, Section 29 to Lake Billy Chinook.

8. The Department finds that in order to prevent injury and enlargement the applicant's request must be modified. Clarification of the rate at which water is to be leased instream in Season 3 is necessary. The quantity of water to be leased instream for Season 3 has been proportioned based upon the findings made in Finding 5 above. The volume of water to be leased instream has also been modified. At the rates identified below, only 50.85 AF may be leased during the full period requested. Therefore, the Department finds that water may be leased instream as follows (changes are shown in bold text):

Reach: From the Swalley Main Canal POD (SE NE, Section 29, T17S, R12E, W.M.; 985 feet North and 617 feet West from East 1/4 Corner, Section 29 to Lake Billy Chinook.

- 9. To prevent injury an enlargement, the amount of water to be leased instream under certificate 74145 accounts for a 43% transmission loss that may not be leased and protected instream.
- 10. Based upon review of the application, information provided by the Department's Watermaster, and other information, the Department finds that the lease, as proposed and modified above, will not result in injury or enlargement.
- 11. The instream lease application identifies that the lease is to terminate on November 2, 2008. However, the last day of the irrigation season is October 31st. Therefore, the lease will terminate on October 31, 2008. The lessor has requested the option of terminating the lease early, with written notice to the Department.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department concludes that the lease, as modified above, will not result in injury or enlargement, OAR 690-077-0077.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. That the Short-Term Lease described herein is APPROVED.
- 2. The authorized place of use shall not be irrigated during the term of this lease.
- 3. Water is leased instream as follows:

Reach: From the Swalley Main Canal POD (SE NE, Section 29, T17S, R12E, W.M.; 985 feet North and 617 feet West from East 1/4 Corner, Section 29 to Lake Billy Chinook.

4. The lease will terminate on October 31, 2008. The lessor shall have the option of terminating the lease each year, prior to the lease being exercised (April 1), with 30 days written notice to the Department.
