**Findings of Fact**

1. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10218 in the name of Lonnie Wright, on January 29, 2008. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 74, at Page 99. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2009.
2. On June 24, 2009, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-10218 from Lonnie Wright.
3. The applicant has completed the construction of the additional point of appropriation and the irrigation system is in place and operational. 112 acres have been irrigated.
4. The applicant was unable to complete the change under the terms of the order, within the time allowed, because the 15 acres of land under Temporary application T-10511 will need to be irrigated after the expiration date of October 1, 2010.
5. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2011.

**Conclusions of Law**


Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10218.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-10218 shall be extended to October 1, 2011.
