ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7502 submitted by

HENRY ROSHAK (ROSHAK LIVING TRUST)
16035 ROSHAK ROAD
TIGARD, OREGON 97224.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 30332, as modified by orders of the Water Resources Director, approving Transfers 5626 and 5689, was perfected under Permit G-488 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 7, 1957. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 1.0 ACRE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 6, T 2 S, R 1 W, WM; NORTH 63° 54' WEST, 1200.8 FEET FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 6, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.0 ACRE
SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


The applicant proposes to change the use to YEAR-ROUND DOMESTIC USE INCLUDING UP TO ½ ACRE NON-COMMERCIAL LAWN AND GARDEN. The applicant also proposes to change the point of appropriation to the NE¼ NE¼, SECTION 7, T 2 S, R 1 W, WM; 850 FEET SOUTH AND 100 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 7.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The proposed point of appropriation (well) shall be cased and sealed into the basalt aquifer. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right, except for up to ½ acre non-commercial lawn and garden in conjunction with the domestic use.
6. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed a rate of 0.013 cubic foot per second and a volume of 2½ acre-feet per year. The water may be use at any time during the year.

Certificate 30332 was cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
