ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6903 submitted by

BOB FESSLER 11796 MONITOR-McKEE ROAD NE WOODBURN, OREGON 97071.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 36211, was perfected under Permit G-2720 with a date of priority of JULY 29, 1964. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 208.2 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.45 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ NE¼, SECTION 1, T 6 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 1370 FEET NORTH AND 1510 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER LOT 3 (NE¼ SW¼), SECTION 1, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ 33.5 ACRES SE¼ NE¼ 38.0 ACRES LOT 2 (SE¼ NW¼) 18.0 ACRES LOT 3 (NE¼ SW¼) 12.3 ACRES 22.4 ACRES NE¼ SE¼ 13.2 ACRES NE¼ SE¼ AS PROJECTED WITHIN QUIGLEY DLC 55 NW¼ SE¼ 24.4 ACRES NW¼ SE¼ 10.9 ACRES NW¼ SE¼ AS PROJECTED WITHIN QUIGLEY DLC 55 SW¼ SE¼ 21.0 ACRES AS PROJECTED WITHIN QUIGLEY DLC 55 SE¼ SE¼ 14.5 ACRES AS PROJECTED WITHIN QUIGLEY DLC 55 SECTION 1 TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes an additional point of appropriation at:

NE¼ SE¼, SECTION 1, T 6 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 490 FEET NORTH AND 2180 FEET EAST OF THE SW CORNER, LOT 3 (NW¼ SW¼), SECTION 1.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
