FINAL ORDER

Applicant

Findings of Fact

1. Transfer Application 9681 was filed April 1, 2004. The application requested an additional point of diversion for a portion of the water right evidenced by Certificate 80695.
2. Transfer Application 9681 was approved by an order of the Water Resources Director, entered September 20, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 542.
3. The date for the complete application of water under the terms of the transfer was set for October 1, 2005. A Claim of Beneficial Use was required to be submitted prior to October 1, 2006.
5. On September 14, 2007, a certified letter was sent to the transfer holder of record allowing 60 days to submit the required claim. The Department warned that if the required claim was not submitted, a water right certificate would be issued which reverts the points of diversion to the last authorized points of diversion.
6. A Claim of Beneficial Use was not received.
7. In accordance with OAR 690-380-6010, the points of diversion shall revert to the last authorized points of diversion.


This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The points of diversion for the right affected by Transfer 9681 revert to the last authorized points of diversion.
2. A new certificate describing the right shall be issued.
