ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7814 submitted by

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 30029, was perfected under Permit 21652 with a date of priority of MARCH 28, 1950. The right allows the use of SALT CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-24551, PERMIT R-1405, a tributary of the SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 327.2 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.65 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LOT 3 (NW¼ NE¾), SECTION 14, T 6 S, R 5 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acrefeet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-1405.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The applicant proposes to add an additional point of diversion to:

SE% NE%, SECTION 11, T 6 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 400 FEET SOUTH AND 3750 FEET EAST FROM THE NE CORNER OF BILLING DLC 48.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.
- 5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.
- 6. The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The water user may participate in the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's cost sharing program for installation of screening and by-pass devices in accordance with ORS 540.525.

Certificate 30029 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
