FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The subject water right evidenced by Water Right Certificate 27072 is proposed to be canceled for non-use of 0.02 cubic foot per second of water from West Fork Illinois River, tributary of the Illinois River for irrigation of 0.9 acre in the SE1/4 NW1/4, Section 26, Township 40 South, Range 9 West, W.M. The priority date is March 14, 1955.
- 2. On November 17, 2011, Barbara A. Nelson and Judith H. Zulliger submitted affidavits alleging nonuse of water right evidenced by Certificate 27072 from April 1994 through April 1999.
- 3. The entirety of Water Right Certificate 27072 is proposed to be canceled for non-use of 0.02 cubic foot per second of water from West Fork Illinois River, tributary of the Illinois River for irrigation of 0.9 acre in the SE1/4 NW1/4, Section 26, Township 40 South, Range 9 West, W.M. The priority date is March 14, 1955.
- 4. On December 15, 2011, the Department issued a Notice of Proposed Cancellation of Water Right.
- 5. The Notice of Proposed Cancellation was lawfully served on Robert M. Elting and Anna C. Cornelison, the owners of record of certain real property in Section 26, Township 40 South, Range 9 West, Willamette Meridian, Tax Lot 900, in Josephine County, Oregon.
- 6. Robert M. Elting and Anna C. Cornelison did not contest the Notice of Proposed Cancellation, nor did they request a hearing.

7. The Department has designated its file on this matter, including the materials submitted by the Proponents or Protestants, as the record in this proceeding. The record contains evidence that persuades the Department that Water Right Certificate 27072 was not used from April 1994 through April 1999.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. A rebuttable presumption has been established that a perfected and developed water right has been forfeited due to five consecutive years of nonuse. ORS 540.610.
- 2. The presumption of forfeiture has not been rebutted. ORS 540.610.

FINAL ORDER

It is ORDERED that the water right evidenced by Water Right Certificate 27072 be cancelled in its entirety, being 0.02 cubic foot per second of water from West Fork Illinois River, tributary of the Illinois River for irrigation of 0.9 acre in the SE1/4 NW1/4, Section 26, Township 40 South, Range 9 West, W.M. The priority date is March 14, 1955.

Judicial review, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 536.075 and ORS 183.482 is to the Oregon Court of Appeals. If you do not file a petition for judicial review within the 60-day time period, you will lose your right to appeal.
