**Authority**

ORS 537.455 to 537.500 and chapter 726, Oregon Laws 1997 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request for an allocation of conserved water. OAR Chapter 690, Division 18 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating allocation of conserved water applications.

**History**

In October 2005, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) began work to reduce traffic through the City of Redmond by re-routing Highway 97. The Highway 97 re-routing project was known as the Redmond Bypass Project. The Redmond Bypass Project required ODOT to pipe 1.27 miles of the North Canal (also known as the Pilot Butte Canal) and approximately ¼ mile of the F-Lateral. ODOT used 96-inch, steel pipe on both canals, which had previously been opened and unlined. ODOT completed the project in March 2006.

**Findings of Fact**

1. On January 12, 2010, the Deschutes River Conservancy (DRC), and Central Oregon Irrigation District (COID), filed an application for Allocation of Conserved Water. The Department assigned the application number CW-67.
2. On January 30, 2013, COID sent a request, by electronic mail, to withdraw Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-67.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-67 is withdrawn and of no further force of effect.
