Authority

ORS 540.570 and 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On October 10, 2013, Medford Irrigation District (MID) filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728, and water use Permit S-4951. The Department assigned the application number T-11673.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 22, 2013, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On April 11, 2014, the department received from the applicant the location of the authorized place of use to be transferred.
- 4. On April 15, 2014, the Department signed a final order, which was mailed on April 23, 2014, and recorded in Special Order Volume 92, Pages 176-184, approving Transfer Application T-11673 involving Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728, and Permit S-4951. The final order established October 1, 2015, as the date for completion of the authorized changes in place of use.
- 5. On December 23, 2019, it came to the attention of the Department that there are scrivener's errors in the order recorded in Special Order Volume 92, Pages 176-184 as follows: two parcels were split between two quarter-quarters, but the entirety of each parcel was only listed in one of its quarter-quarters, and one section number and three quarter-quarter locations were incorrectly described for multiple certificates involved in the transfer; 6.35

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

acres were listed as lands being transferred under Certificates 80578 for supplemental irrigation from locations not authorized on the certificate; and 2.5 acres were listed as lands being transferred under Certificates 83728 for supplemental irrigation from locations not authorized on the certificate, and 0.7 acres authorized on the certificate needed to be included.

- 6. This order is issued to correct the scrivener's errors described in Finding of Fact 5, above, and supersedes the final order approving Transfer Application T-11673, recorded in Special Order Volume 92, Pages 176-184. All corrections and deletions are consistent with the maps submitted with the application and the water rights of record. The corrections to the authorized and proposed places of use are show in **bold**, deletions are shown in strikeout.

- 22. The District permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.
- 23. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).

- 24. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 25. The proposed change in place of use will not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-11673 satisfies the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The order entered at Special Order Volume 92, Pages 176-184 is withdrawn and of no further force and effect and is superseded by this order.
- 2. The changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-11673 to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728 and water use Permit S-4951 are approved.
- 3. The right to the use of water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in by Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728 and water use Permit S-4951 any related decree or order.
- 4. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights or water use permit.
- 5. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 6. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2015. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted by MID to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 7. Water right by Certificates 83381, 83383, 80578, 83728 and water use Permit S-4951 are modified. The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the rights when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.
