## ORDER APPROVING TEMPORARY CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523 after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 8061 submitted by

KRAEMER FARMS 13318 DOMINIC ROAD MT. ANGEL, OREGON 97362.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 62397, was perfected under Permit G-10143 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 20, 1983. The right allows the use of TWO WELLS, in the BUTTE CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 46.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.58 cubic foot per second, if available at the original wells; NW¼ NW¼, SE¼ NW¼, SECTION 17, T 6 S, R 1 E, WM; 1200 FEET SOUTH AND 80 FEET EAST, 1470 FEET SOUTH AND 1990 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 17, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The amount of water placed into Butte Creek from the two wells is limited to any deficiency from Butte Creek under the water right evidenced by Certificate 62395. This right is further limited to appropriation of water to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing rights of others.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to discharge the well water into Butte Creek and pump it out at a point located:

NW¼ SE¼, SECTION 31, T 5 S, R 1 E, WM; 1315 FEET SOUTH AND 2080 FEET WEST FROM THE E¼ CORNER, SECTION 31.

THESE TEMPORARY CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The change is temporary. The change shall be effective upon issuance of this order.
- 2. The former place of use shall not be irrigated as part of this water right during the term of this order.
- 3. The water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water discharged into Butte Creek and the quantity of water diverted from Butte Creek. The types and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The amount of water placed into Butte Creek from the two wells is limited to any deficiency from Butte Creek under the water rights evidenced by Certificates 28295 and 34539.

- 5. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2000 irrigation season.
- 6. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
- 7. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 62397 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 62397.
