ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8556 submitted by

TUMALO IRRIGATION DISTRICT
64697 COOK AVENUE
BEND, OREGON 97701.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 12072, was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-102 with a date of priority of MARCH 20, 1911. The right allows the STORAGE OF THE WATERS OF THE DRAINAGE AREA DRAINING INTO CRESCENT LAKE, a tributary of CRESCENT CREEK AND LITTLE DESCHUTES RIVER, IN CRESCENT LAKE RESERVOIR, APPROPRIATED AS PROVIDED BY DECREE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR DESCHUTES COUNTY, OREGON dated February 10, 1928, for IRRIGATION. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 35,000 acre-feet.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 76451, was perfected under Permit R-2744 with a date of priority of DECEMBER 8, 1961. The right allows the STORAGE OF THE WATERS OF CRESCENT LAKE, a tributary of CRESCENT CREEK AND LITTLE

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

DESCHUTES RIVER, IN CRESCENT LAKE RESERVOIR, APPROPRIATED UNDER PERMIT 27841, for IRRIGATION. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 51,050 acre-feet.


The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the use from storage for irrigation to storage for multiple purpose uses.

This change is to allow for the use of existing storage for additional beneficial purposes. No changes to the existing facilities are required. The change is complete and no time limit for completion of the change is necessary.

Certificate 12027 and 76451 are canceled. New certificates will be issued confirming the use which may be made of the stored water.
